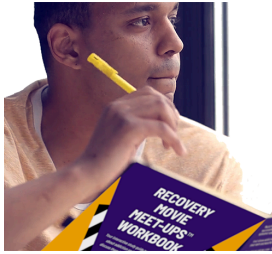


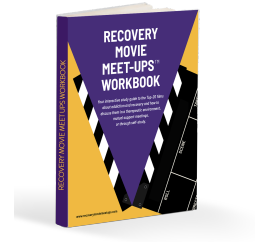
RECOVERY MOVIE MEETUPS™



The **Recovery Movie Meetups™** Program is a new and dynamic mutual support meeting format where your treatment facility screens a curated series of popular films about addiction and recovery in group sessions, and then invites participants to engage in interactive, highly therapeutic discussion afterwards - guided by the **Recovery Movie Meet-Ups Workbook**.

Each Workbook features film summaries on 20 key addiction & recovery-related films, movie trivia, character breakdowns, evaluation of each film's impact and relevance, and Motivational Interviewing-based questionnaires that participants can fill out during or after the screening to then share and discuss in subsequent meetings.

The meeting format works just as well in IP and IOP contexts, and can be a fresh, innovative, clinically-validated (see **Advisory Committee** below) compliment to your existing continuum of care programming that will get your participants energized and engaged in their own recovery process.
